



BUCK O'NEIL BRIDGE




BUCK O'NEIL BRIDGE

U.S. ROUTE 169 IN KANSAS CITY

- Worked with City of Kansas City to procure \$220 million for the project
- 50% complete with construction work
- Foundations and columns completed; structural steel being installed
- Scheduled for completion in December 2023

I-70 MISSOURI RIVER BRIDGE Center span = 2 million lbs.



I-70 MISSOURI RIVER BRIDGE

- First bridge expected to open in late spring 2023
 - I-70 traffic will drive on the new bridge; the old bridge will be taken down before construction starts on second bridge
- Scheduled for completion at the end of 2024

I-270 NORTH

- 75% of project completed
- Work on remaining bridges, interstate lane addition, outer road paving, and ADA facilities near completion
- Scheduled for completion in December 2024







GOV. PARSON'S FOCUS ON BRIDGES


- \$351 million to repair or replace 250 bridges
- All 250 bridges awarded within 3.5 years
- 223 bridges open to traffic
 - 12 bridges currently under construction
 - 15 starting soon

GOV. PARSON'S FOCUS ON BRIDGES



GOV. PARSON'S LOW-VOLUME ROAD PROGRAM

- \$100 million in General Revenue for low-volume rural roads
- 1,700 lane miles in poor condition
- 14 contracts across the state awarded in August 2022
- Deadline for contract work: June 30, 2023
 - Approximately 35% complete to date



BRIDGE BUNDLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS



FARM BRIDGE PROGRAM



- Replacing 31 rural bridges in northern MO
 - Weight-restricted, supported by timber piles, in poor condition, one lane
- 14 bridges completed
- Completion date: Oct. 31, 2023

BOOTHEEL BRIDGE BUNDLE



- 13 are part of Gov. Parson's Focus on Bridge Program
- 13 completed
 - Completion date: Dec. 31, 2023

I-44 CORRIDOR BRIDGE BUNDLE

BRIDGE BUNDLE

- Improve 25 bridges on I-44 corridor
 - 9 rehabs, 16 replacements
 - Minimize disruption to interstate traffic
- Completion date: Sept. 30, 2024

NORTHWEST BRIDGE BUNDLE



- Improve up to 34 bridges in poor condition in north central MO
 - To be advertised

Winter operations


- 6 million miles of snow and ice plowed each year
- \$51 million in FY 2022


Maintaining roadsides






THE CONCERNING: HJR 37

- Would require that the State Road Fund be subject to appropriation by the General Assembly
- Passed the House, now at the Senate for review

THE BAD: TRAFFIC FATALITIES




THE BAD: TRAFFIC FATALITIES

- 2022: third consecutive year of increasing roadway fatalities
 - Second consecutive year of 1,000+ fatalities
- Three people killed each day on Missouri roads
 - Two of the three are unbuckled

LEGISLATIVE EFFORTS

- Safety Omnibus Package: SAFER
- Proposed legislation:
 - Handheld devices
 - Open containers
 - Ignition interlock
 - Child safety seat requirements
